



Reuven Shapira built Airfix' 1/72 HS 125.




Dr. Simon Vichnevetsy built Airfix' 1/72 B-24J. He really liked the kit, but used rear fins from an Academy kit.




Dae DeNardo built Hobby Boss' Pzkpwl Ausf F.

I'm pretty sure Dave took home a trophy from the Nationals, but I can't remember which place, even though I judged the category! (No names on the new forms at Nationals.)






Matt Giordano called this "Balance of Terror" rom a Star Trek episode. The Romulan Torpedo


Is made from a water bottle ring

I'm leaving John Bucholz' SDFKZ 251 Diorama on it's side so you can see it better, real nice work here.



These must be Martin Orlando's.







Now some photos I took at the National Convention.



















Well that's it. I hope you enjoy the photos. I apologize or all the spaces, but formatting these is not easy.
