Also, I'm pressed for time with extra rehearsals for Holiday Concerts, so I'll hold the two articles from Dr. Simon and John B. till next month.



John Bucholz sculpted this 1/35 Cossack figure from.....




Dave DeNardo built Tamiya's 1/35 French Light Tank OOB. Wooden hand plow by Red Wild Diorama.



Matt Giordano continues his Star Trek journey with an Enterprise X with an added expansion kit.




Martin Orlando continues to amaze us with his fine painting skills. These are 28mm Games Workshop WarHammer Orbital Drop Troopers!
